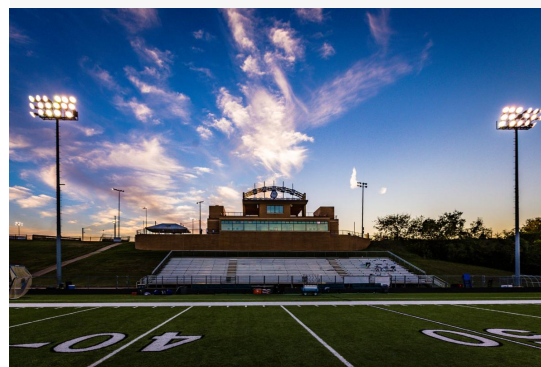

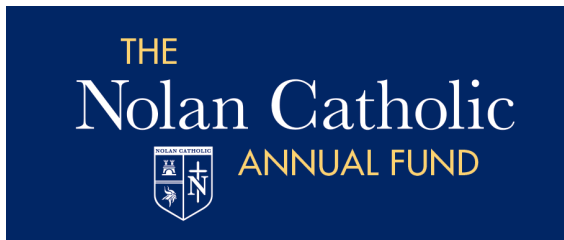
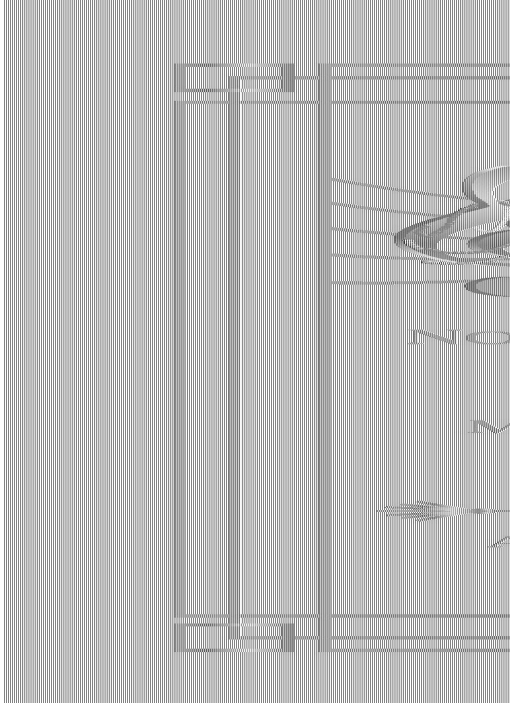

The library has been refurbished giving the space a bookstore feel with chairs to sit and read or gather for small group discussions as well as classroom space. The students are enjoying the new look.

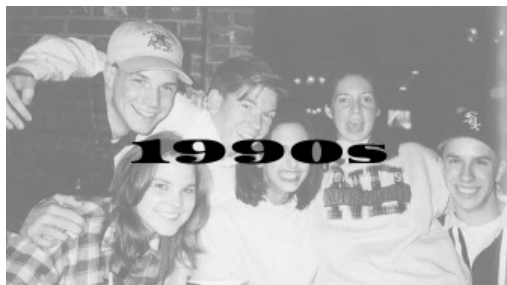

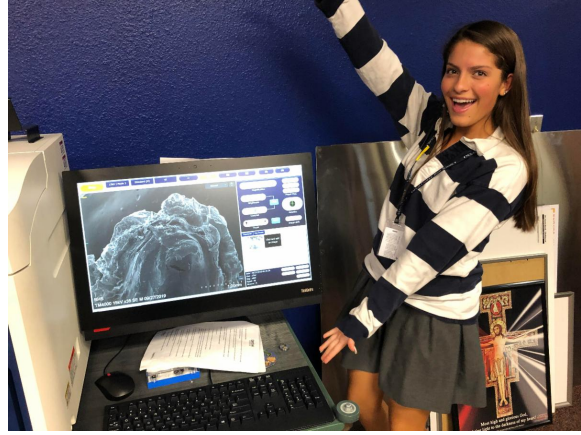
We invite you to join us on Sunday, Nov. 3, at 3 p.m. in our school auditorium for their final performance of this play. Admission will be free.
