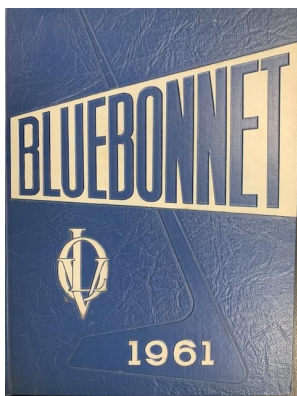

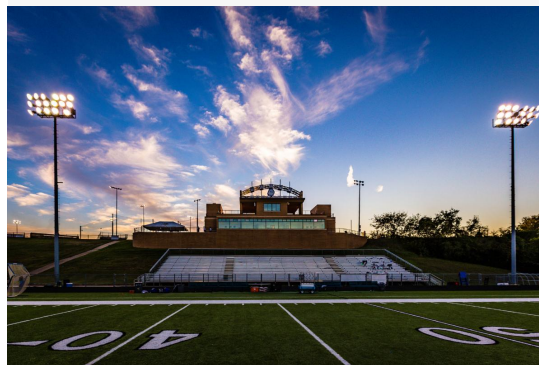

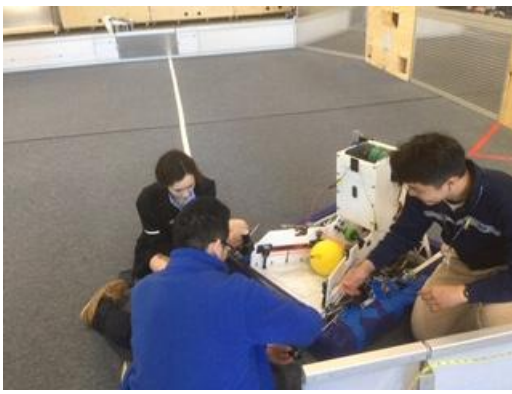


DFW Dallas World Affairs Council Academic Competition

On Feb. 13, members of Nolan Catholic Junior World Affairs Council with their moderator, Mr. David Mabry, competed in a regional Academic Worldquest at UTA. It is an academic competition based on foreign policy, world affairs and current events hosted by the DFW World Affairs Council. Nolan Catholic teams finished eleventh and fiftieth out of more than eighty teams from over thirty schools in the region. This is the first time Nolan has participated in this event. Way to go Vikings!

48th Annual Regional German Contest

Thirty-nine NCHS German students competed along with 400 German students throughout North Texas at the 48th Annual Winterfest Regional German Contest. NCHS students earned 2nd place Sweepstakes for Sports, 2nd place Sweepstakes for Cultural Events, and 3rd place Overall Sweepstakes in the "large German programs" category of which it was the first time for NCHS to compete. Almost 90% of Nolan students who competed earned at least one top-5 finish!



Robo Vikes FIRST Competition

The Robo Vikes will be competing in the FIRST Competition in Fort Worth March 12 - 14. They should be well prepared after practicing in their new space next to the IDEA Building.

Natatorium

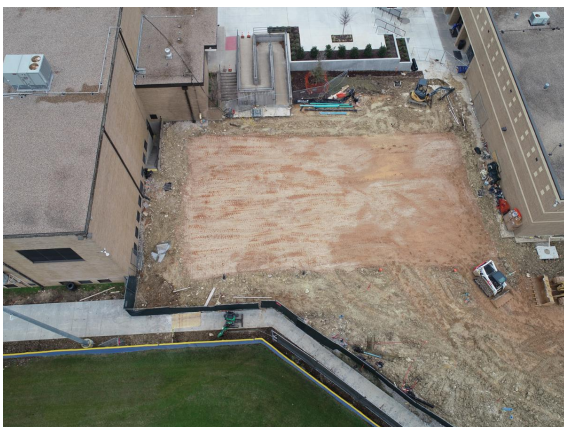
