ENTRANCE

Dress Guidelines

We believe that students can be trusted to make smart choices regarding appropriate attire for Commencement and the events leading up to it.

Below are guidelines to follow for all three of the required ceremonies:

Girls: Dresses, dress pantsuits, or skirts and blouses with modest necklines showing no cleavage. Hem length should be to the top of the knee. Girls' shoes should be considered dressy. No flip-flop style sandals are acceptable. No strapless, no tight clothes.

Boys: Dress pants with a shirt and tie. Dress shoes and socks. That means closed shoes and closed heels. No flip-flops or sandals. Boys must be clean-shaven and wear appropriate hair styles. (No oddly bleached, colored, spiked, or shaven hair.)

CEREMONY EXPECTATIONS

There are two distinct parts to this ceremony. The first part is the robing ceremony and the second part is the presentation of the academic awards.

During the robing ceremony, each Senior is asked to choose the faculty/staff member to robe them who they believe has had a significant impact on their life while at NCHS. Seniors are called to the front of the stage and the faculty member chosen by the Senior places the graduation robe on the Senior. They will also place all regalia on the student.
