What is Human **Trafficking**

Human trafficking is a severe violation of human dignity. It strips individuals of their freedom and treats them as commodities for exploitation. Everyone is created in the image of God and deserves to live with respect, safety, and dignity. Human trafficking robs people of these basic rights, making it an issue that affects us all.



Under the direction of Bishop Michael Olson the Diocesan Human Trafficking Awareness Initiative seeks to educate and empower our communities to recognize, prevent, and respond to human trafficking. By offering tools and knowledge, we aim to protect our most vulnerable—children, teens, and young adults —from this grave injustice.

- Empowering teens and young people to stay safe and informed.
- Creating a culture of awareness and justice in our community.




Senior Yearbook Ads
