CURRICULUM

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Nolan Catholic requires a four-year core curriculum in English, Mathematics, Laboratory Science, History, and Theology.
- Students are required to take at least two years of World Language (French, Latin, or Spanish). Students may elect to take a World Language course for up to four years.
- Nolan Catholic offers Advanced Placement (AP), Honors, and Dual Credit courses, all of which are considered advanced courses.
- Tarrant County College awards college credit to all "Dual Credit" courses.

GRADING & CLASS RANK

Grading is numerical only; no equivalents are given. Nolan Catholic uses the scale below:

A	90-100
B	80-89
C	70-79
F	69 and Below

- Grade Point Average (GPA) is represented as a cumulative average on a 100-point scale.
- In computing GPA, Nolan Catholic awards an additional 8 points on the semester grade of all Advanced Placement (AP) and Honors Courses. Dual Credit (DC) courses earn an additional 4 points on the semester grade.
- Nolan Catholic does not rank its students annually.
- Rank is only disclosed to the top 10% of rising seniors at the end of students' 6th semester (end of junior year).

ENGINEERING PROGRAM

Nolan Catholic follows a Project Lead the Way (PLTW) curriculum. PLTW Engineering students adopt a problem-solving mindset and engage in compelling, real-world challenges that help them become better collaborators and thinkers, preparing them with skills for any career path they choose. Students in the PLTW Engineering program at Nolan Catholic have the opportunity to complete four years of engineering coursework, culminating in a final-year "Capstone Project."

Advanced Placement, Dual Credit, and Honors

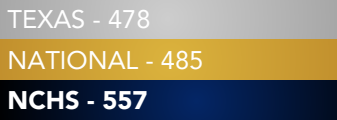

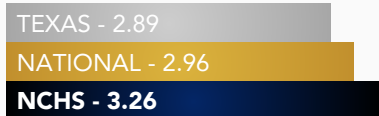
