Christian Ministry Service Hour Program

Our service hour program encourages students to look outside of themselves to see how they can serve our school and neighboring community. Students are required to complete 75 approved service hours to graduate: 25 hours by the start of their sophomore year, 25 hours by the start of their junior year, and 25 hours by the start of their senior year. As a reminder, hours must be verified in order to be considered for approval.

2024-2025 School Year Information:

• 9th Grade

In the first quarter, freshmen will go through CM Hour training where they will learn about our Christian Ministry program, create their x2VOL accounts, and learn how to log service hours. Please be on the lookout for a follow up email after they are trained. We know many of our freshmen and transfers may have served this summer. Students will be able to log these hours once they have completed their CM Hour training.

• 10th-12th Graders

We hope many of our students were able to serve this summer! The due date for any hours completed over the summer is **Friday**, **August 23**. All hours from May 31 - August 13, 2024 must be <u>logged and verified</u> by August 23. Please take time to reach out to your service contacts to make sure that they verify the hours in which you have served. Any students who have not hit their yearly goal of approved hours by August 23 will be put on a recovery plan to make up the deficient hours.

• All Students

All hours completed during the 2024-2025 school year must be logged and verified by May 30, 2025.
